C24/25.133: Methodist Church: Members considered a briefing note regarding the sale of the old Methodist Church at 42 Cuckfield Road, Hurstpierpoint via an on-line auction from 4-6 February 2025. Members had reviewed the Business Case, RICS Valuation and Building Condition Survey and considered both the community and the financial implications of the decision, and it was:

RESOLVED: That the Council unanimously **AGREED** not to bid at the 6 February 2025 auction for the purchase of the old Methodist Church or to request a loan from the Public Works Loan Board at this time, due to the significant costs and financial risks associated with a poorly maintained building, and despite the excellent community facility it could provide. Should the building not sell at the auction for any reason, the Clerk is authorised to ask the auctioneer for access to the building for a Structural Survey.
